- 4 The Authority will confirm an entry in the Mortgage Register by returning a photocopy of the relevant entry to all parties named overleaf and to the current registered owner.
- 5 Once accepted, a Priority Notice is valid for fourteen working days including the date of entry. To maintain priority, the contemplated mortgage must be made and entered in the Mortgage Register, or a further Priority Notice entered, within the fourteen working day period.
